

SUBSCRIPTIONS FOR 2023 - 24 March 1, 2023 to February 29, 2024

Your committee has reviewed both Income sources and Expenditure costs for the coming year and as a result it is recommending a Membership fee for Active Members of \$75 per person for the coming year (an increase of \$5.00). The Joining Fee, Meeting Contribution Fee (\$5) and Non Members Fee (\$10) will remain unchanged.

Reason for increase

Fixed cost have increased - PSPL capitation fee increases by \$1.50 p.p.

Active Membership numbers have decreased since 2019 (last fee increase) from 128 to 100 Active members thus reducing revenue less members to share the costs.

General costs are continuing to increase.

Membership fees are due and payable by March 31, 2023. EFT MSHP + Name

At our next meeting I will ask members to vote on our proposal.
