A great roll up indeed. Several members enjoyed a tippie or two before leaving. Others enjoyed a small size Fillet Mignon with veg & mash. Just superb!

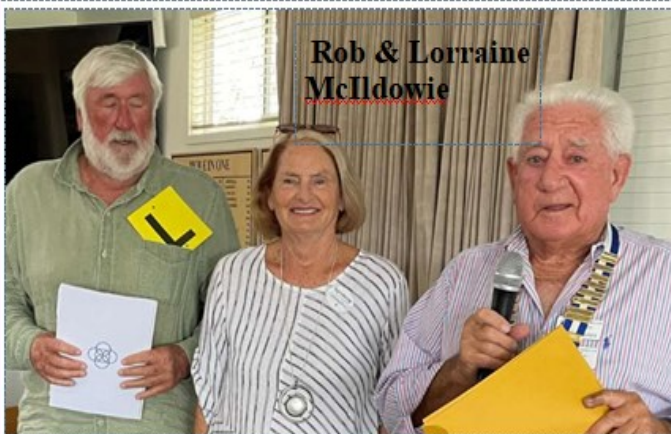

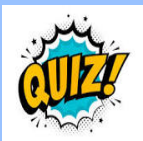
There were many comments about the nature of the student works, with a number of works presenting a rather sombre Generation Z view of the world.

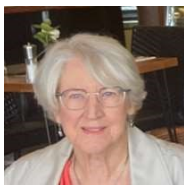
