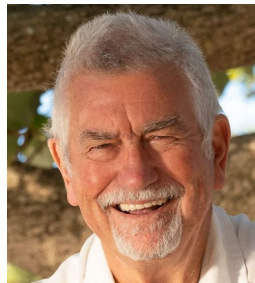

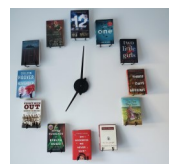

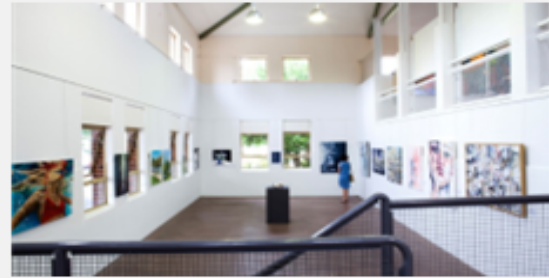

Secrets on the Lake - Lunch

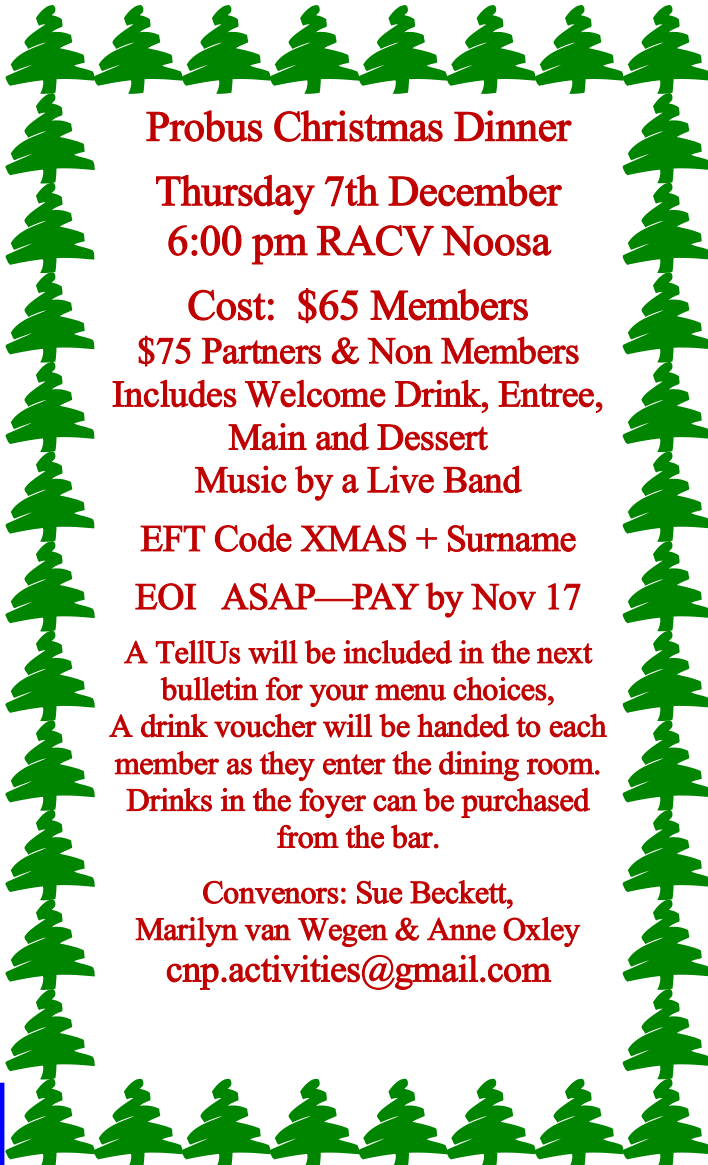

REPORTS - Walkers

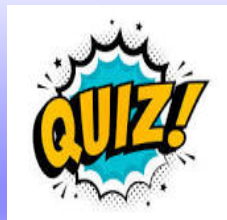

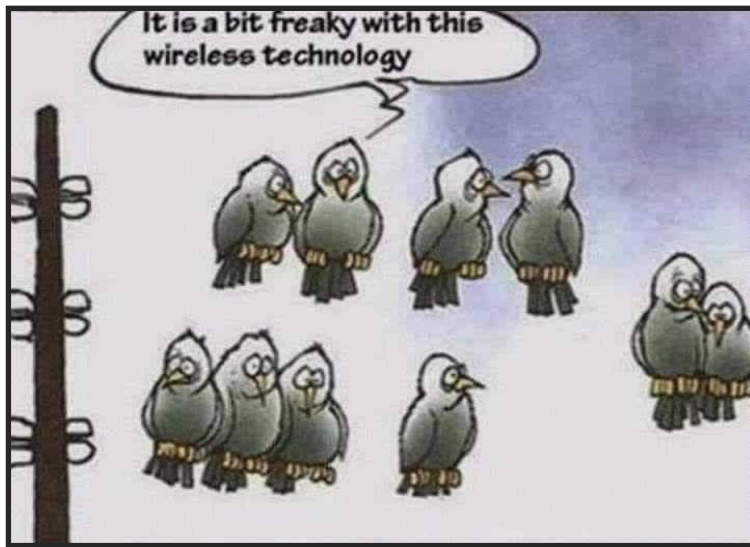
