- Option 2** Provide your driving licence and phone number.

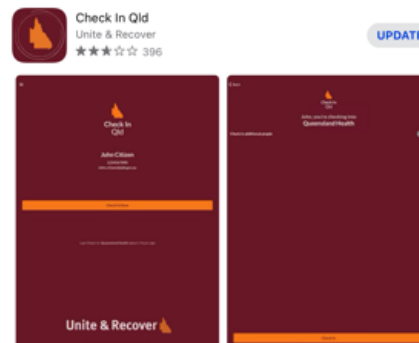
Should you use Option 2, you will receive a printout of your arrival time. You will then need to either sign off on your way out or give the printout to one of the staff to process for you.

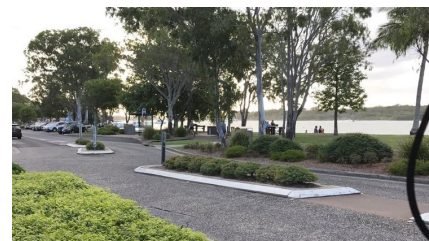

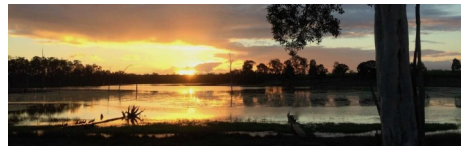

Cabins: \$130 per night (There are only 7 cabins so please book early if interested)

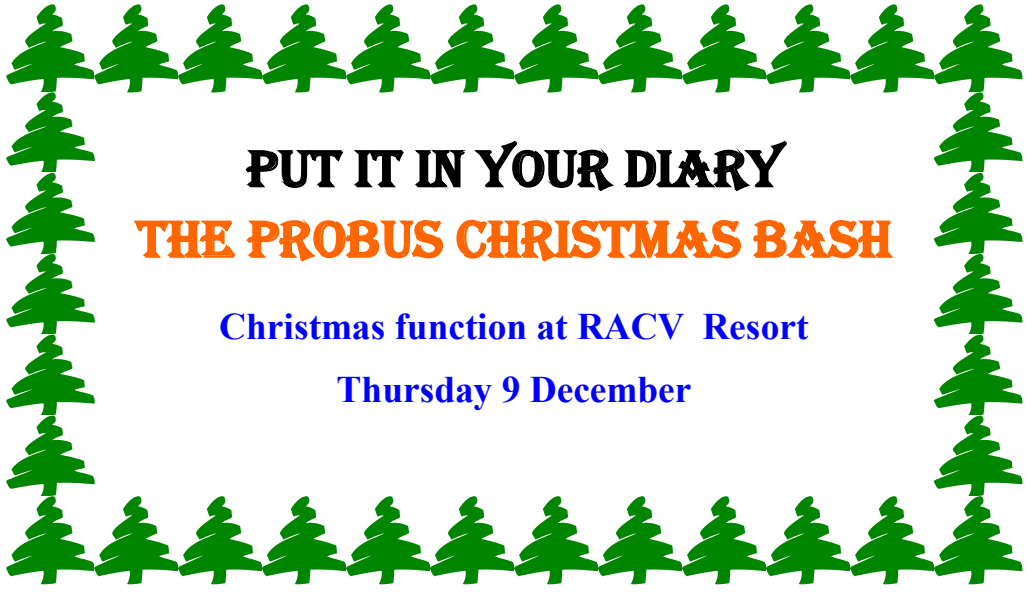
Depending on our numbers we may be able to get a discount on our bookings.

European Masterpieces from the METROPOLITAN MUSEUM OF ART, NEW YORK

Works include Fra Angelico, Titian, Rembrandt, Turner, Van Gogh, Raphael, Caravaggio and Monet direct from the Met's collection, one of the finest collections of European paintings in the world, the majority of which never leave permanent display in New York.

Being optimistic and a year away, I'm thinking that we may be able to travel abroad in the European summer, so many of you may not be here in the first months. Therefore, I think it would probably be better if I made the time end of September/October 2021.

Many of you will have seen this collection at the Met of Art in New York but the more you see them the more you discover in them.

As Brisbane is the only place to see this exhibition in Australia, I think there will be a queue for tickets so I would like to get ours within the next month or so.

I will try to get a private tour if we get the numbers and of course hire a bus to take us there and back. We will also have lunch somewhere in South Bank.

If there are still restrictions then numbers allowed in at one time may be limited due to social distancing. I will also make time for us to go back at our own time over the exhibition, as private tours do not show all the paintings or give one time to study them.

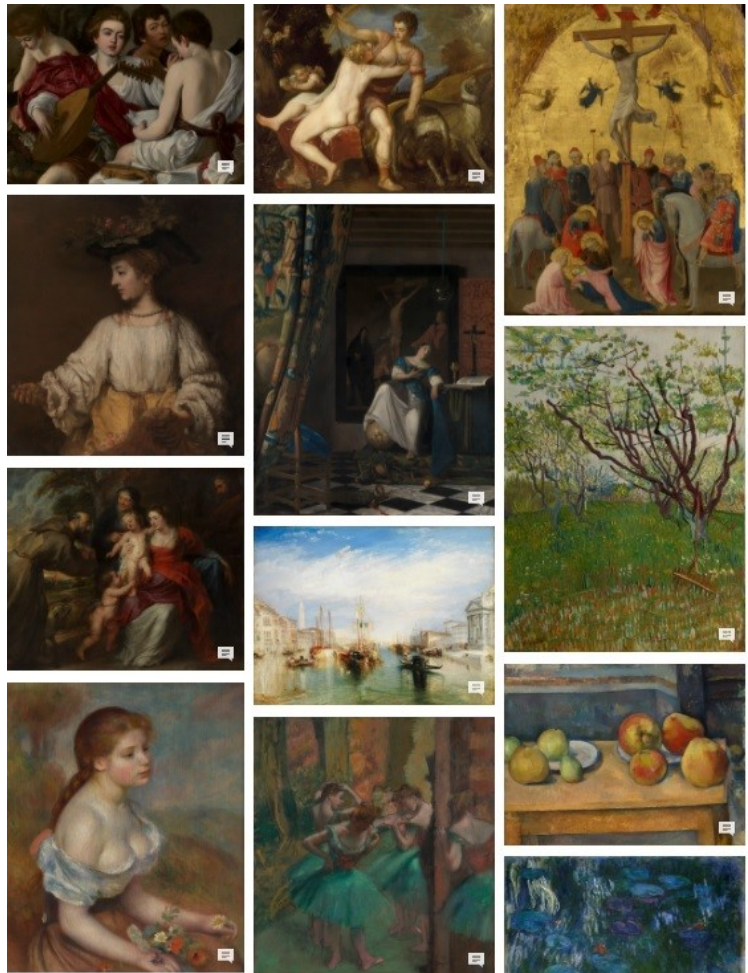
