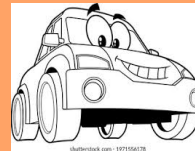

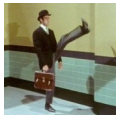

The highlights were a cruise to Carlo Point for lunch and being welcomed by the locals at the Snack Shack for a wonderful jam session.

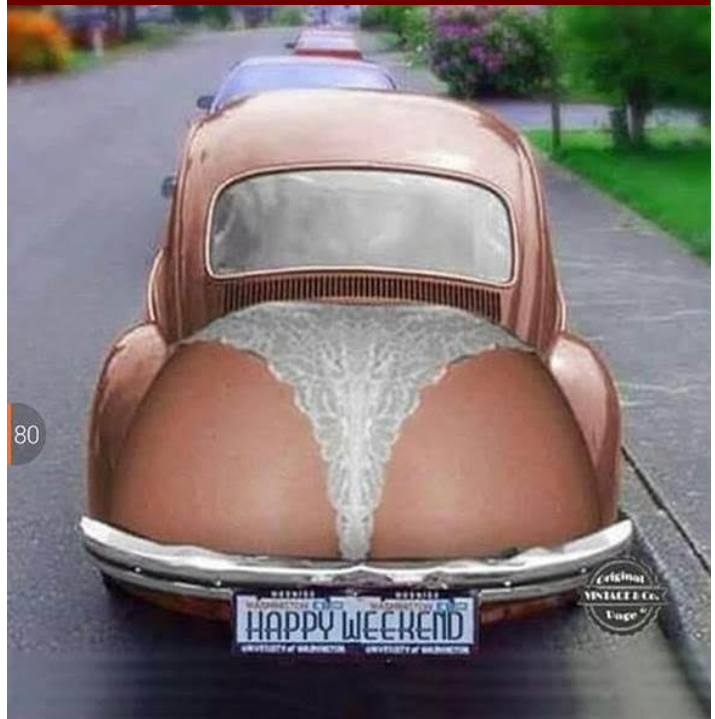

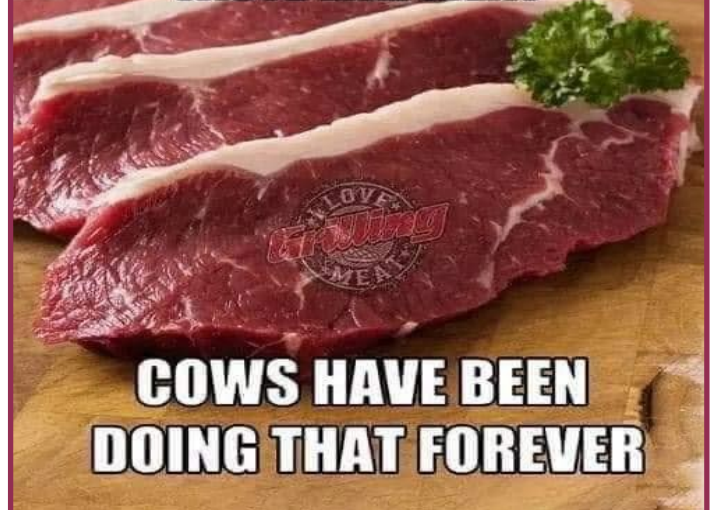
