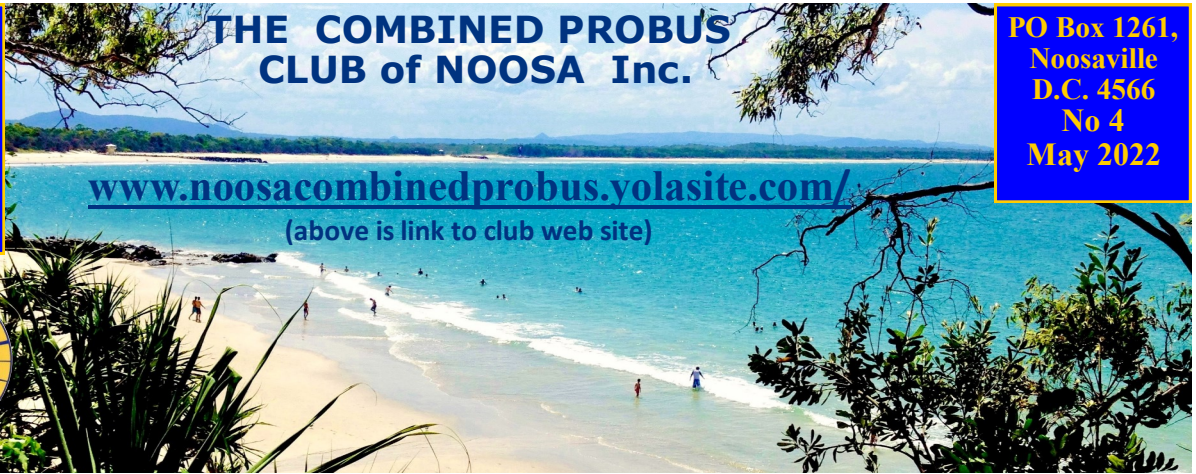

April's Guest Speaker, Police Officer Jess Phillips, recommended one way screws for number plates. These can only be removed by a special tool at the Police Station and not by thieves.

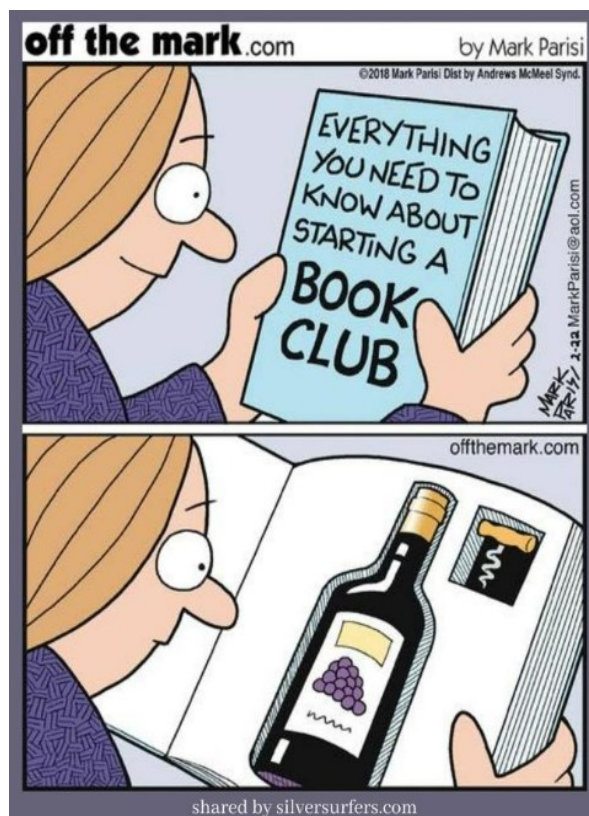
